5. Be open minded and open to listening to other opinions even it's different than your own.



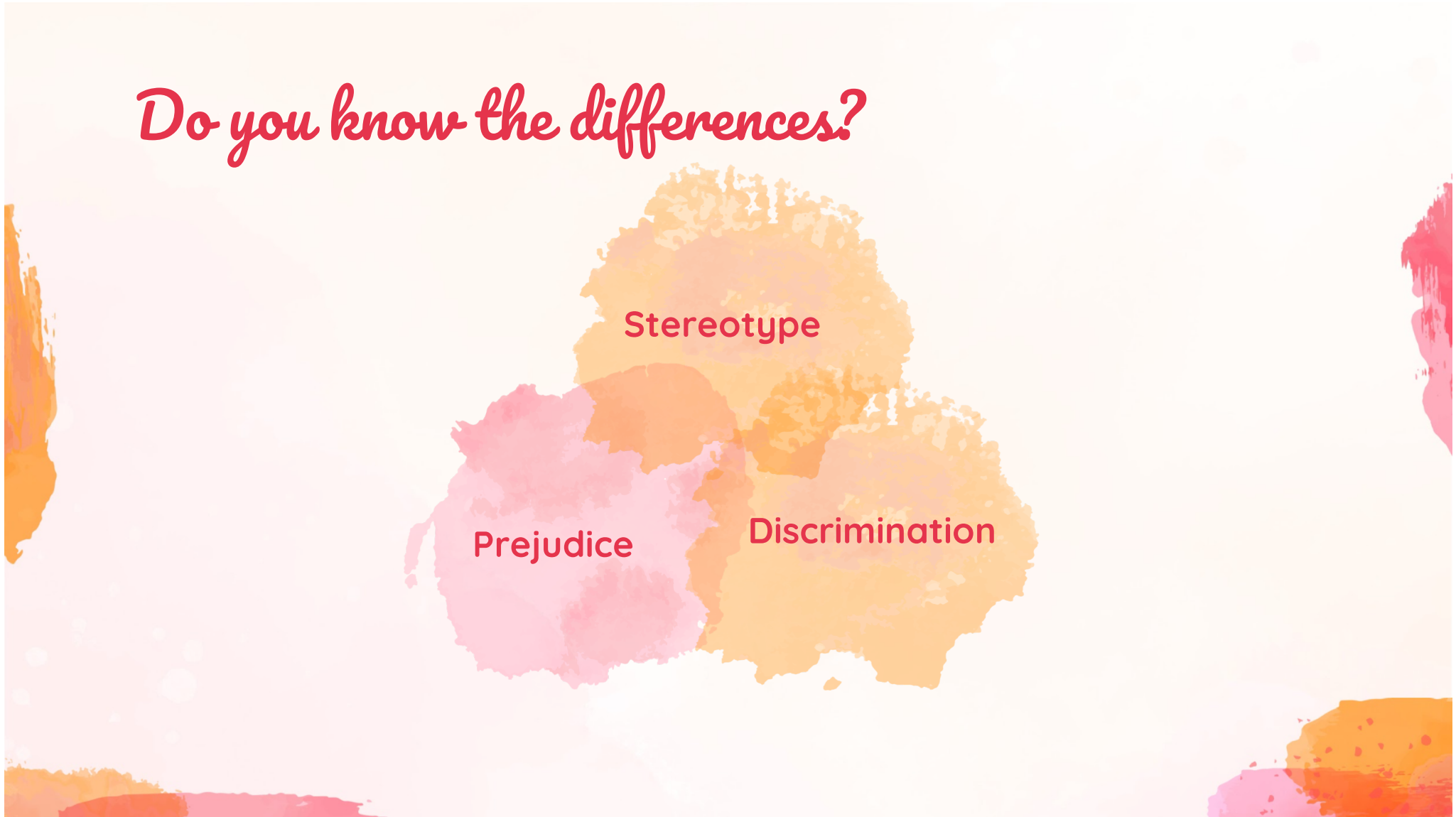
